## Sport Team Attendance Policy

---

At Ascham, participation in sport has always been an integral part of our students' daily life. Our comprehensive sporting program aims to instil values such as discipline, focus and integrity, whilst also promoting the importance of team work, commitment and lifelong physical activity to personal growth and development. It is important that the girls enjoy their sport and they are encouraged to provide feedback to the Head Coach or the Head of Sport if they have any concerns regarding training or games.

It is compulsory to attend all training sessions throughout the season.

- If you are unable to attend due to an ongoing school commitment, you are expected to organise an alternative training time with the Head Coach of that sport at the beginning of the term.
- If you are unable to attend due to illness, you are expected to notify your Head Coach prior to the training session. Girls are encouraged to attend alternative sessions to ensure they continue their development.
- If you are injured, you will need to discuss your situation with the Head Coach of that sport to discuss your options and rehabilitation.

If no notification is received the process outlined below will be put into place.

1. The Head Coach will pass the information to the Head of Sport. In the first instance, the Head of Sport will email the student a warning. In the second or subsequent instance(s) the Head of Sport will place that student on a Friday afternoon detention.
2. If a student is continually absent from training or matches she will need to meet with the Head of Sport.
3. If the Head of Sport is unsatisfied with the explanation then it will be referred to the Deputy Head for further action. This may involve parent notification.
