

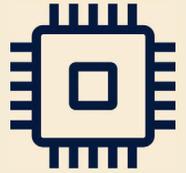


BYOD Guidelines

Hardware

- A laptop is the recommended BYOD, not a tablet
- It must support 2.4 GHz and 5 GHz wireless networks
- It must support the 802.11n wireless protocol
- It's recommended it support the 802.11ac wireless protocol

- The laptop should have a minimum of 8GB of memory.
- An 8-hour battery life is recommended



Operating System

The laptop must be running the current or previous version of either the Apple Mac OS, or Microsoft Windows operating systems



Software

- The laptop must have an up-to-date AntiVirus / Anti-Malware program
- Ascham offers Sophos AntiVirus as a free download for Students
- Microsoft Office 365 and Adobe Cloud are also licensed for Students

Support

ICT can support Students with:

- Connecting to the Wireless network
- Connecting to the Internet (Chrome browser recommended)
- Approved software installation:

Warranty and Repairs

- It is strongly recommended that the laptop include a warranty for the useful life of the computer. (e.g. 3 years)
- Purchasing warranty for BYOD is the responsibility of the parent/carer
- Warranty claims for BYOD are the responsibility of the parent/carer



Not Supported

- Fault diagnosis, warranty claims, hardware and software repairs
- BYOD will not be bound to the School domain
- BYOD will not have a Standard Operating Environment (SOE) provided for by the School
- BYOD will not have School licensed software installed on them (unless this is specifically permitted in the terms of the software agreement e.g Microsoft, Adobe)
